Stephen Blyth is Professor of the Practice of Statistics at Harvard University, where he teaches quantitative finance. His book, *An Introduction to Quantitative Finance*, was published by Oxford University Press. Dr. Blyth served from 2006 in various roles at the Harvard Management Company, the wholly owned subsidiary of Harvard University responsible for the management of the University's endowment, including as President and Chief Executive Officer 2015-2016. Before joining Harvard, Dr. Blyth was Managing Director and head of the global rates proprietary trading group at Deutsche Bank in London, and Managing Director in the derivative products group at Morgan Stanley in New York. Dr. Blyth earned a PhD in statistics from Harvard University and an MA in mathematics with first class honours from Christ's College, University of Cambridge.
